Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held in the

Monday 30th January 2012 at 7-15pm

Present Councillors Pickles Jackson Berry Broadley and Fraser and 18 members of the public. County Councillor Richardson and District Councillor Atkinson.

1. Apologies for absence – Councillor Nicholson and Councillor Tyreman
2. Matters arising – none.
3. The minutes of the previous meeting on Monday 19th December 2011 were proposed as a true record by Councillor Berry and it was seconded by Councillor Broadley. Councillor Fraser signed them.
4. Declaration of interest – Councillor Fraser declared an interest in a planning application.
5. Correspondence
  - a) Parish Council elections Thursday 3rd May meeting for prospective Councillors 6 March 6pm Harrogate Council Chamber nominations must be in by Wednesday 4th April two seats will be up for election at Laverton and 5 in Kirkby.
  - b) Kirkby Malzeard cemetery proposal for parking spaces, initial plans were shown and Councillors indicated approval. A formal Planning Application will be submitted in time. Clerk to reply that Councillors are in favour of looking into parking spaces being provided.
  - c) Back Lane south - new sign Lorries banned will be provided by Highways and concerns as another tanker got stuck.
  - d) Nidderdale Plus update – keeping eyes open for any future opportunities to work together.
  - e) Diamond Jubilee update – In the Main Hall there is an outline of the proposed programme. Parish Council has precepted £1000 towards the celebrations in the whole Parish. Which the Jubilee committee seek to use to match fund.

6 Planning

- a) Erection of detached dwelling land to the rear of Ivy Cottage Main St Kirkby Malzeard E422820 N474276 Mr Brian Wensley 6.24.53.E.FUL 11/04678/FUL- wrong information had been sent last month. Every official body who should have had the information was sent the

wrong information so the application has been re-sent with correct information this time by Harrogate Council Planning Department with a new deadline for comments date and so the Parish Council will look again at this application. Correspondence giving objections has been delivered by Mr Robinson and Miss Trott to all Councillors except Councillor Fraser who pointed out that he was Chairman and although he would once again declare an interest and not vote he should have received one. The clerk also received a copy. After this point Councillor Fraser left the room and Councillor Jackson took over the chair. Councillors were asked to comment and then vote. 2 B - 2 D casting vote therefore cast by chairman- B clerk will reply The Parish Council objects that the proposal is contrary to the Village Design Statement, concerns about access, impact on neighbours and it will set a precedent for the rest of Back Lane North if a new build allowed here.

b) Installation of package treatment plant Sycamore Farm Kirkby Malzeard for Mr D Holt 6.24.39.I FUL 11/05272/FUL- A The Parish Council has no objections.

c) An application has been made to Harrogate Borough Council for non material amendment to allow installation of solar panels at land west of Lyn Garth by the Diocese of Leeds. Harrogate Borough Council has approved this application.

d) Notice of decision – passed agricultural building Raper.

e) Planning Enforcement – Highfield. Erection of wall encroaching on to common land. The land has been proved to belong to the property (Highfield) and no action will be taken.

#### 7 Finance

a) Fulfil obligations promised: Pre School –£250 Highside Playing Fields £375 , Mechanics Committee. £1000. It was proposed by Councillor Berry that they be paid – cheques issued.

b) Mechanics room hire £158.40 proposed by Councillor Pickles that this be paid cheque issued.

c) Yorkshire in Bloom cheque has been sent by Councillor Jackson – £40 as due in so as this has been precepted for cheque issued to reimburse Councillor Jackson.

8 Any other report – tree on Laverton land – Councillors are covered by insurance and the clerk. But volunteers working on the tree would not be. Landowner is to use his insurance if there is any accident concerning the tree. Councillor Jackson reported – no light from Shoulder of Mutton to the top of Church Street. - This will be put on agenda for next month's meeting - Councillors please take a look before then. NY volunteers may be doing footpath repairs throughout the Parish.

Members of the public asked if they had any comments to make.

Request that Bus Shelter be looked at – lots of litter. And needs a tidy up and some general repairs. Needs lots of money spending or demolishing . Put on next agenda. To formally discuss – meanwhile Councillors all take a look at it please. Trees are now being removed from Rose Garden and it looks much better.
